### Information from Migration Team, Coventry City Council EU Settlement Information from The Migration Team

The EU Settlement Scheme closes on 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021, we are trying raise as much awareness as possible to ensure that EEA citizens and their family members (spouse, children, grandparents, carers etc.) are supported to make an application to the scheme, remain legally in the UK and have their right secured. This is particularly important given the introduction of a new points-based immigration system, for arrivals to the UK after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 and for those who do not apply, a possible No Recourse to Public Funds restriction.

We provide *free* confidential and independent advice and support for EEA citizens and their family members. Dependent upon need, free services also include document retrieval, evidencing residency and interpretation. For more information please contact
